THE WORKSHOPS

Exploring The Creative Process

A drama workshop designed for fun and expression. This workshop uses drama games and techniques that give children the chance to be creative and explore the artistic process.

Creative Writing Through Drama

Suitable for years 3-6, this workshop uses drama techniques to stimulate the imagination to create stories and plays. It looks at story structure and dialogue, characters and motivation as well as encouraging the participants to work together and have confidence in their own creativity.

Issue Based Improvisation

Created for Personal and Social Education and Citizenship modules. These workshops look at sensitive topics in a safe environment using themed drama games and improvisation whilst at the same time getting to the core of the issue and stimulating discussion

English Schemes Workshop
